We will soon be celebrating the day of Pentecost, when we commemorate the arrival of the gift of the Holy Spirit which Christ had promised would assist his apostles after his death. On that day the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles like tongues of flame, allowing them to speak in languages that all people, no matter their ethnic, cultural, or national background could understand. But our celebration on Pentecost does not stop at our remembrance and recognition of this one specific instance of the Spirit acting in the lives of believers. On the day of Pentecost we are reminded that *all* Christians are given this very same gift that Christ promised the apostles. And just as the Holy Spirit bestowed certain gifts and abilities onto the apostles, so the Holy Spirit causes spiritual gifts to spring up in each and every one of us. It is then up to us to discern what our gifts may be and how God is calling us to use those gifts to further God's work in the world.

Yet the gifts of the Spirit are not meant to work independently from each other, but together for the common good. Though we each have individual callings, we also have larger callings that we must work together in order to accomplish. Because the sum of our gifts can achieve much more than what we could as individuals. Thus, one of the reasons we Christians congregate together in churches is to share the gifts of the Spirit that we each possess so that we might discover how our combined gifts can be used to do God's work in our communities and in our world.

It is very appropriate then, that we will continue our efforts to develop a new mission statement after the service on June 4th, the day of Pentecost. Our new mission statement will be an expression of what we believe God is calling us together as a church to accomplish, how our combined gifts can be used to a higher calling in our community. And just as each Christian manifests a gift of the Holy Spirit, each member of St. Thomas has gifts and wisdom to share. Please join us after the service on the day of Pentecost as we seek to define our common mission.
