I have said many times that if we want things to be different, we must do things differently. St. Thomas is already a wonderful, friendly, worshipful place, and we now have the opportunity to be more welcoming and include more people into our faith family. As most everyone has heard by now, on September 11th, the first Sunday after Labor Day, we will begin having two services at St. Thomas. The 8:30am service will generally be a Rite II Holy Eucharist with no music, and the 10:30am service will generally be a Rite II Holy Eucharist with music. As we have in the past, we will have Rite I services when it seems more appropriate for the liturgical season. I am very excited about this new path we are following, and hope that we will all be able to put aside the anxiety that always accompanies change and look towards all of the wonderful possibilities of what God may have in store for us.

Several people have asked about what coffee hour and worship ministries will look like once we have two services. There will be a coffee hour after each service, unless we're doing a combined parish social hour between services. There will be two different rotations for coffee hour—one for the 8:30 and one for the 10:30. There will also be two different rotations for altar, ushers, readers, etc. If you are on the rotation for refreshments, altar, readers, etc. on a Sunday, fear not. You will NOT be serving at both services. I will be meeting with various groups starting in August to figure out the new rotations bases on which service each person plans on frequenting, so please think on which service you prefer to attend if you are involved in any of these ministries.

We are reaching a turning point in St. Thomas' history. As comfortable as the status quo may be, we have the opportunity to create more options for our current members and for people searching for a community that they can worship God in—a place where they can come meet God and then go out into the world and do God's work. Let us embrace this new opportunity, knowing that God will continue to be with us in the midst of the changes and chances of this life.
